Papakura Trolley Derby

**All trolleys and competitors
must pass a safety inspection
before being qualified to race**

Rules:

- The same trolley can only be used in a maximum of two categories.
- Each trolley may be driven by only one person in any one class
- All entrants must pay a non-refundable \$20 entry fee
- Trolleys must run on at least three wheels
- Trolleys must have an effective braking system
- Gravity is the only power source
- Drivers must be seated, facing forward
- Maximum Trolley length: 3000mm
- Maximum Trolley width: 1200mm
- Minimum Trolley ground clearance: 50mm
- The forward most point of the trolley may be no more than 200mm from the ground
- Angle of turn of the trolley must be no more than 20° in either direction
- Hand held rope steering will NOT be permitted
- You must race in your own age group

Safety Requirements:

You must: wear a helmet, wear long snug fitting pants, wear a long sleeved snug fitting top, wear covered footwear.

Race Day Rules:

- You must be registered and be signed in on the day to race
- Your trolley must pass scrutineering
- You must obey the officials on duty
- You must race in a straight line from the start **to the finish**

**It is your responsibility to have your trolley
ready for and removed from each race.
Officials may remove or exclude any
competitor if they are not obeying the rules!**

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Schools Cup

In addition to the above rules:

- The trolley must be made at school; proof may be asked for
- The driver must be a fulltime student at the school/college.

Race Day Notifications

- Safety comes first — follow all race officials' instructions
- While speed is part of the fun, the focus is on enjoyment!
- Marshalls will help ensure you're in the right race. But if you miss it, you may not be re-entered
- Every competitor gets at least two races
- Participants must listen for the announcement of their next race
